

Requirements for placement of names on the St. Clair County Memorial Tablets (SCCMT)

As established by the St. Clair County Allied Veterans Council, April 2011

1. Each name submitted must be researched by The St. Clair County Memorial Tablet Committee and approved at a regular meeting of the St. Clair County Allied Veterans Council
2. All names submitted and approved for a calendar year will be dedicated on the next Memorial Day, (example nominated in 2010 calendar year – added May 2011)
3. Each person submitted must have at least 1 (one) of the following county requirements:
Born, schooled, current or former resident of, or buried in St. Clair County
4. Each person must be a member of the United States Armed Forces;
Air Force
Army
Coast Guard
Marine Corps
Navy or
Army, Air Force, Marine Corps, Navy or Coast Guard Reserve
Michigan Army or Air National Guard
5. Each person must have died while serving in a conflict area, combat theater of operations, war zone, and peace keeping missions or engaged with a hostile adversary including terrorist attacks.
6. The person submitted could have died at a later date of wounds-suffered in a hostile area, combat theater of operations, war zone, and peace keeping missions or engaged with a hostile adversary including terrorist attacks.
6a. Deaths from Chemical or Biological weapons attacks should be considered on an individual bases.

Many precedents have been set by past SCCMT committees for name placement on the SCCMT. These precedents include but not limited to:
died from accidental causes including "Friendly Fire", accidental destruction, aircraft crash, or died of illness in a "combat" area or traveling to or from a "combat" assignment.
